On 28th March National Bank of Malawi plc donated sophisticated equipment to maternity theatre of Bwaila Hospital, in Lilongwe. The equipment worth K13.0 million consisted of a theatre lamp, an adjustable theatre bed and monitor.

Bwaila Hospital popular known as “Bottom Hospital” was built during the colonial era and was meant for Africans (Malawians) as the whites had their own hospital within the City. Today, Bwaila is the biggest maternity facility in the sub-Saharan Africa in

terms of deliveries with an average of 50 babies per day. The hospital serves all locations in and around Lilongwe.
